

Healthy Snack Information for Y3 and Y4

Now that your child is in years 3 and 4 they will no longer receive a free piece of fruit or vegetable during their break times (even if your child in entitled to Free School Meals), as this is a Government Scheme administered by the Department of Health for KS1 pupils (Year R-2).

If you would like for your child to have a piece of fruit etc. at break time, please ensure you send them in with a healthy snack. This could be a piece of fruit, a vegetable or a yoghurt drink. Children will not be permitted to eat crisps or chocolate at break times.

Timings of the School Day



Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

As you will be aware **all** children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 get a Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM). These are free of charge and not linked to any benefits a family may claim.

However, we would like you to be aware that should you be on a low income, you should still apply for free school meals to that your child's school can claim the Pupil Premium, this can range from (£55 to £1,345 per year. This extra money is paid direct to schools for each child eligible for free school meals and used to support your child's education.
