

In these sessions parents and carers of SEN students can meet to discuss a range of SEN strategies, develop a supportive network, and learn about SEN resources within the local area.

#### Anti-bullying Pop Up Day—Friday 1 December

This year's theme: 'Make A Noise About Bullying'.

We have already had antibullying assemblies delivered across the Lower School site with special visits from Mr Wilkinson



and Miss Side. On Friday, all King's Oak Academy children had an opportunity to learn about speaking up, harmful effects of bullying and things we can all do to support one another. This will also be an additional chance to learn about acts of kindness and sprinkle our Ruby Power all around our school!

What is Anti-Bullying Week?

Anti-Bullying Week is a nationwide initiative that highlights the issue of bullying and encourages individuals to take action against it. It emphasises the importance of fostering a culture of respect and support, where bullying is not tolerated, and every person is valued.

#### **Progressive Sports Enrichment**

Lower school children have had a wonderful time in their Progressive Sport enrichment sessions this term. They have been able to demonstrate heaps of emerald and sapphire power in box fit sessions while learning new skills.

#### **Explorer Dome Sessions**

Our Years 3, 4 and 1 children had an absolutely magical and awe-inspiring time during their onsite visit from the Explorer Dome this term. It was a fully interactive, immersive, and hands-on experience for all our learners. Year 3 & 4 scientists completed an investigation into light and colour, explored what light is, where it comes from and how it travels. They were able to use mirrors and prisms to explore reflection and refraction and get hands on with light inside the darkened Dome. Our Year 1 scientists enjoyed the 'Winter Show' and had an opportunity to explore the science behind the seasons and discover more about mid-winter festivals from around the world.


