

Democracy is a culture built upon freedom and equality, where everyone is aware of their rights and responsibilities.


We have started to explore our termly Learning Gem Power and our termly values in classes and will continue to work on these in assemblies throughout the term






#### Miss Baber's Maths Challenge - April

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


