Dear King's Oak Middle School Families,



Year 4 into Year 5 (Welcome to Middle School!):

- Throughout Term 6, Year 4 children will have the amazing opportunity to take part in weekly forest school sessions on Monday afternoons; this will enable them to spend more time getting used to the site, getting to know more staff and having input into their environment. Year 4 children will also spend some time with the current Year 5s to re-connect and build our community.

Social Awareness, e.g. empathy and compassion, mutual respect, perspective-taking, conflict resolution.

Relationship Skills, e.g. collaborative problem-solving, leadership, honesty, resisting negative social pressure.

Responsible Decision-Making, e.g. self-discipline, reasoned judgement, problem-solving, evaluate consequences of actions.

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
