Dear Parents and Carers

Today we received confirmation of a positive COVID-19 test from a Year 7 student. This is the third case within the year group.

Following our track and trace procedures I can confirm that **your child has not been identified as a close contact with the Year 7 student who has tested positive**. This means that your child is welcome to continue to attend the academy next week and they should continue to comply with the national lockdown and post lockdown Tier 3 rules outside of school hours. **However, if your child is already self isolating from one of the two previous positive cases, then please refer to your original letter about when your child should return to school.**

It is likely that your child's timetable will be adjusted to reflect the number of students who will be learning on site. Please could you advise your child of this and let them know that when they arrive at school on Monday morning, we will ensure that they are informed of any timetable/room changes for the week ahead.

I want to reassure everyone in our community that we are working tirelessly to keep everyone safe during the pandemic and that we have taken all the necessary steps in line with current Public Health England guidance. I want to thank you for your support in navigating this turbulent time.
