Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to confirm that students in Reception to Year 11 are invited to come to school on Friday 15 November in a spotty or stripey top or socks to raise money for Children in Need, who support children both locally and nationally.

An example of a local project that has benefitted from this national fundraiser is the 'Bristol Creative Therapy Centre C.I.C' who have received £39,122 to provide child-centred creative therapy sessions for children and young people to work through trauma and difficult feelings.
