Dear Parents/Carers

Important Notice: E-Scooters and E-Bikes on School Premises

We would like to take this opportunity to update all parents and carers of our policy regarding electric scooters and electric bikes on school grounds.

E-Scooters

Due to UK law, privately owned electric scooters are not permitted for use on public roads, pavements, or cycle paths. As such, we regret to inform you that E-Scooters are not allowed on school premises under any circumstances. Please ensure that your child does not bring an E-Scooter to school, as they will not be permitted on-site.

E-Bikes

E-Bikes are only permitted if they meet the following legal criteria:

- They must have pedals that can be used to propel the bike.
- The motor must not exceed a power output of 250 watts.
- The motor should not propel the bike beyond 15.5 mph.
- The rider must be at least 14 years old.

If an E-Bike meets these conditions, it is treated as a regular bicycle and can be used accordingly. However, please note that:

- E-bikes must be stored outside and away from emergency exit routes.
- Charging of e-bikes on school premises is strictly prohibited.
- We strongly encourage the use of only manufacturer-approved batteries and components that meet UK safety standards (UKCA or CE marked) to reduce fire risk.

Student Responsibility

Whilst we understand that E-Bikes and bicycles are a convenient mode of transport, we must emphasise that all students remain fully responsible for their personal property. The school will not be held liable for theft or damage to any bikes or scooters brought onto the premises.
