Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you and your family are well. I write today to update you on some staff changes at King's Oak Academy.

Head of Lower School and All-Through Leadership

As you know, Jo Thorn (Head of Lower School) is leaving King's Oak Academy at the end of Term 4. On Tuesday 22 March we will be holding interviews to appoint the new Head of Lower School who will join King's Oak Academy in September. So that we can continue to provide high quality leadership across our all-through academy, we have made arrangements for Craig Jones (Senior Principal, Hayward Village Academy) to work with our Senior Leadership team at King's Oak Academy and lead our Lower School (Reception – Year 4) in Terms 5 and 6.

Craig has been a primary school headteacher for 8 years and Hayward Village Academy (Weston-super-Mare) is his second headship. Craig has also taught in primary schools in Bristol, South Gloucestershire, Kent and Dubai.

Craig will continue to serve as Principal of Hayward Village Academy. The table below shows the on-site leadership arrangements that will be in place for King's Oak for Terms 5 and 6. Starting next week, Craig will be transitioning into King's Oak by working with teachers and students and familiarising himself with King's Oak and in particular with the Lower School. He is looking forward to meeting with parents and carers very soon.


