### **Consultation on the Draft Admissions Policy for King's Oak Academy 2023/24**

Admissions authorities are required to consult on their admission arrangements whenever a change to the arrangements are proposed, or if no changes are proposed, every 7 years. As such the Cabot Learning Federation is consulting on the admissions arrangements for King's Oak Academy, for students joining from September 2023.

**The consultation period will run from 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021 to 11th January 2022.**

The academy is amending its policy to make clear that the PAN for external students is 90. The full capacity in Year 7 is 150 students, of which 60 places are reserved for Year 6 students already on roll at King's Oak Academy (an all-through academy) that will automatically move up to Year 7.
