Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to thank each of you for the exceptional way you and your child/ren have managed in the face of adversity throughout the pandemic and I hope that you will all be able to have a restful summer holiday soon.

We are pleased that the level of COVID-19 circulating in the wider population has decreased sufficiently to allow the government to ease lockdown restrictions on 19th July. Throughout the summer period, our premises, health and safety and leadership team will continue to monitor the government and local authority guidance closely so that we are appropriately prepared to welcome back your child/ren in September.

We expect that there will be some additional covid-19 related updates from the government in August therefore, as you can imagine, there remains a degree of uncertainty about what the start of term will look like for our students and there will be a lot of information for us to share with your child.

To allow us to welcome each student in to the academy in September, we have arranged a staggered induction session for each year group on Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th September (illustrated below).

Schools have also been asked to supervise two on-site Covid (Lateral Flow) tests at the start of term. We want to do this as quickly and effectively as possible within a week so that school can start uninterrupted by Monday 13th September.

Students in Year 7-11 will complete their first of two 'return to school' lateral flow tests (LFT) during their Induction Session. The second LFT will then take place during the school day on either the Thursday 9th or Friday 10th (3 days after their first LFT). An LFT consent form will be sent to you during the summer holiday period for you to complete, prior to your child participating in their LFTs.
