Airbus STEM Trip – Tuesday 06 February 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Science Technology Engineering and Technology (STEM) programme, we are offering students the chance to attend **Airbus in Filton** on **Tuesday 06 February 2024**.

Airbus is proud to be celebrating the National Apprenticeship Week (NAW) in 2024. As a part of this, Airbus, and the British Gliding Associations (BGA) Go Gliding team, are organising an event at Airbus' Filton site and would like to provide local schools the opportunity to join them.

The proposed itinerary includes:

-  Tours around several facilities on the Airbus site.
-  An interactive STEM workshop centered around wing-bend in an aircraft.
-  *Go Gliding* will be bringing a team with gliding simulators.
-  Career discussions with apprentices from Airbus.
-  An opportunity to learn and ask questions about their projects and activities with employees from Airbus.

As well as the on-site activities, *Go Gliding* are offering the participants of the event an opportunity to apply for a scholarship. Airbus hope that students will have fun whilst learning a lot about aviation and the careers available. Students will then demonstrate their knowledge with a short quiz. Those who score well and are recommended by their teachers will be invited to apply for the £500 scholarship for a lucky individual to attend a local gliding club and learn to fly (possibly even flying solo by the end).

We will be leaving for the event on **06 February** at **8:15am** and arriving back at school at **2:45pm**. Students will need to be in full school uniform and will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you would like a packed lunch to be provided, please indicate this on the form below.

We are asking for a payment of **£4** per student, to cover the cost of travel, which will be available to pay via Scopay once your child's place has been confirmed.

Spaces on this trip are limited and will therefore be allocated on a first come, first served basis. If you wish for your child to participate, please complete the permission form below and return it to **Upper School Student Reception** as soon as possible and no later than **Tuesday 23 January 2024**. I will then contact you to advise you that their place has been confirmed and payment via SCOPay will be made available.
