Term 2 Information for Year 2

Well done for a fantastic Term 1 and an excellent start to Year 2. We are really impressed with the way that everyone has adapted to our new routines and the effort that has been put into learning so far. We are particularly pleased with the effort that has gone into reading at home this term!

- **P.E** this term will be on a **Monday** and **Wednesday** . Please send children to school dressed in their PE kit. We will endeavour to be outside as much as possible, so please ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather.
- **Reading:** We will change children's reading books **every week on Wednesday**. Children should bring their reading book and reading record into school every day. Children are expected to read at least 4 times per week. Please record any reading your child does at home in their reading record, as these will be checked by class teachers on a weekly basis. We have a reading raffle incentive this year and each week there is the chance to win a book. Children reading twice a week will have one raffle ticket in the pot, and those who read 4 times a week will have two raffle tickets. If you have any questions about reading with your child, please speak to a member of the team.
- **Homework** will be the same as last term. This will include the homework menu, home reading and spellings that will be sent out every **Friday**. These spellings will recap what we have learned in phonics that week.
- **Nativity:** As we approach our Christmas Nativity, we are busy making plans, learning songs and assigning roles. Year 2 will have the speaking roles this year. We will send out more information later in the term about your child's role in the Nativity.
- **Winter Weather:** As the weather gets colder, the children will continue to go outside for break time unless there is heavy rain. Please make sure that the children have appropriate clothing to go outside.
