Term 4 Information for Year 2.

Welcome back to school! We hope that you enjoyed the half term break. We were impressed with how hard your children worked last term and we are excited to see what they achieve in Term 4. Please see below for important dates and information which will be relevant for this term.

- **P.E.** will be on **Tuesday and Friday**. Please send children to school dressed in their PE kit. We will endeavour to be outside as much as possible, so please ensure children are dressed appropriately for the weather. We are lucky to have expert PE teacher Miss Jones teaching year 2.
- Reading: Children are expected to read at home at least 4x per week. Children should be taking their
 reading books and records home every day and ensuring that they are back in school the following
 day. Reading records will be checked on a Thursday in order to write out raffle tickets for the reading
 raffle to be drawn in the assembly on a Friday.
- Uniform Please ensure all uniform, packed lunches, drink bottles, etc. is labelled clearly.

Learning at home:

- Reading: Children are expected to read at least 4x per week.
- **Homework menu:** Children can choose from a range of different activities which will be linked to our subjects this term.
- **Spellings:** We will not be sending home spelling lists this term but instead a weekly spelling or grammar activity. This will help to consolidate school learning.
- **Handwriting** This term we will be having a big focus on children using correct letter formation and their handwriting presentation. Handwriting mats will be available should any children want to take one home. This will help to model correct letter formation if children want to practise at home.
- Maths: Home learning sheets will continue to be sent home weekly. These are 'chilli' challenges-children are free to choose which chilli section they are more confident in completing. Again this will consolidate maths learning taught in class.
