## **Term 2 Information for Year 2**

Welcome back! We hope that you enjoyed the half term holiday. Please see below for important dates and information which will be relevant for this term.

- P.E. will be on Tuesday and Friday. Please send children to school dressed in their PE kit. We will
  endeavour to be outside as much as possible, so please ensure children are dressed appropriately for
  the weather.
- Reading: We will change children's reading books every week (Thursday). Children should bring their
  reading book and reading record into school every day. Please record any reading your child does at
  home in their reading record, as these will be checked by class teachers on a weekly basis. Those
  children that have read four times will earn two raffle tickets which will be entered into a weekly
  draw for a chance to win a brand new book to take home!
- Uniform Please ensure all uniform, packed lunches, drink bottles, etc. is labelled clearly. We are
  still getting frequent messages about lost uniform- please feel free to come and check your child's
  draw and class jumper box at the end of the day. Additionally, as the weather is getting increasingly
  less predicable please could all children bring a waterproof coat to wear at playtimes.
- Pencil cases- Some children towards the end of the last term were bringing in their own pencil cases to use. Please can we refrain from bringing in own equipment as it tends to cause more distraction and anxiety for the children!
- **Toys** similarly with the pencil cases can we ask that children <u>do not</u> bring in small toys from home. It is really difficult to look after these and to keep them from getting lost!

## Learning to Learn at home:

- Seesaw- Just a reminder that important updates will be uploaded to Seesaw including topic webs and homework menus. Pictures of learning will also be shared for you to see some of what your children are doing in class. We will endevour to do more of this this term now we are more familiar with the app. We are aiming to keep Seesaw as a 'learning platform' so any other admin related eniquires such as letters please contact the office as normal.
- Spelling Learning task: We will set 1 x ten-minute learning task every Friday. This is normally a set of 10 words containing the phonic sounds children have been taught that week. We do review these the following Friday but it is a very low-pressured 'test'.
