You will still get the same wider opportunities that Lower-School children get.

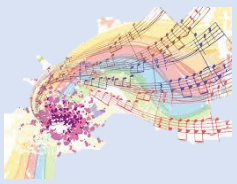


Your teachers will still look after you, just like your teachers do now. If you use a wobble cushion, ear defenders or fiddle support, you will still use these.
