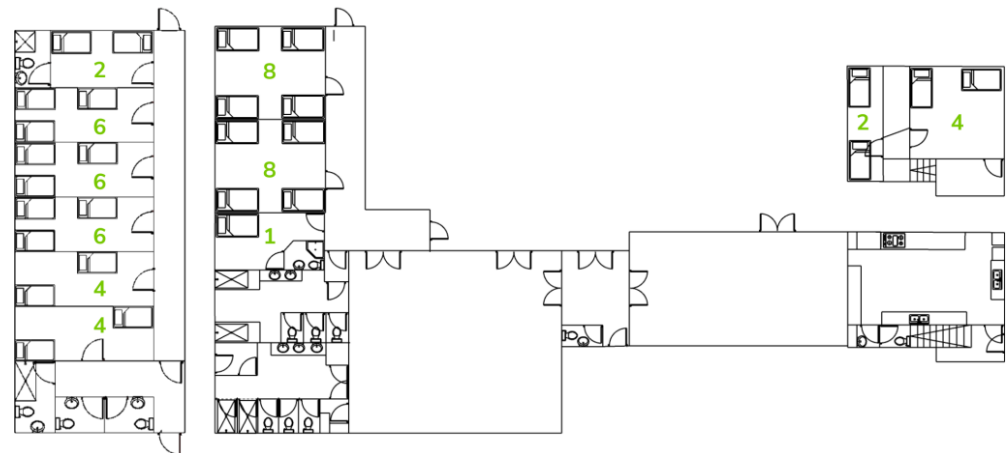

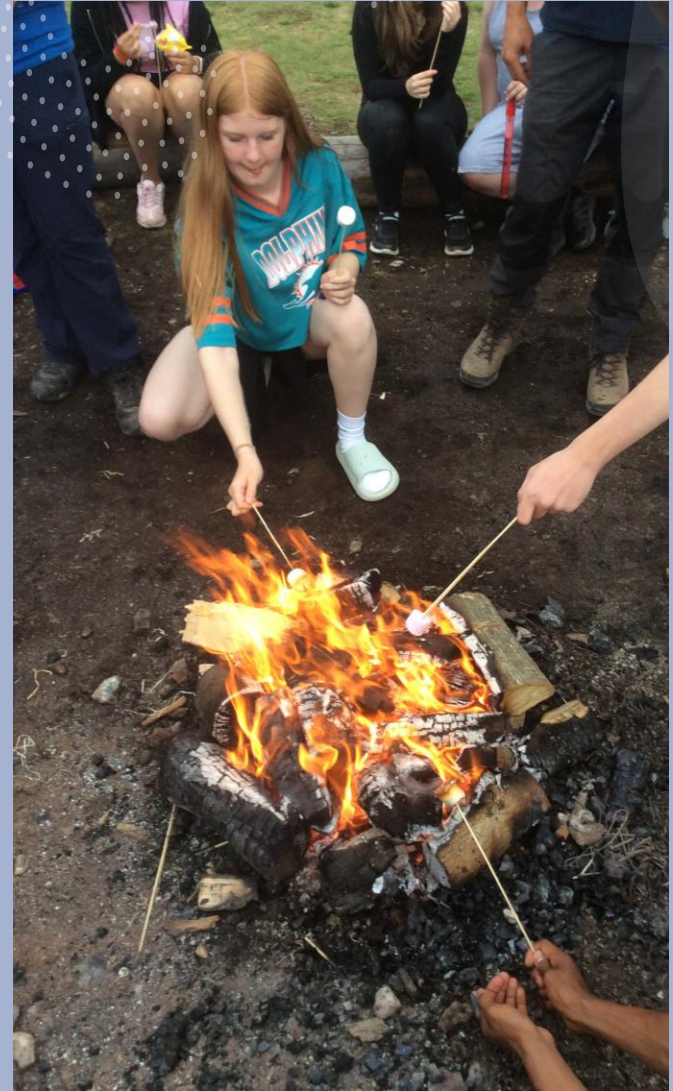

- Travel Sickness tablets should be taken before boarding the coach. Please give another tablet to Emma Watts in a named envelope for the return journey.

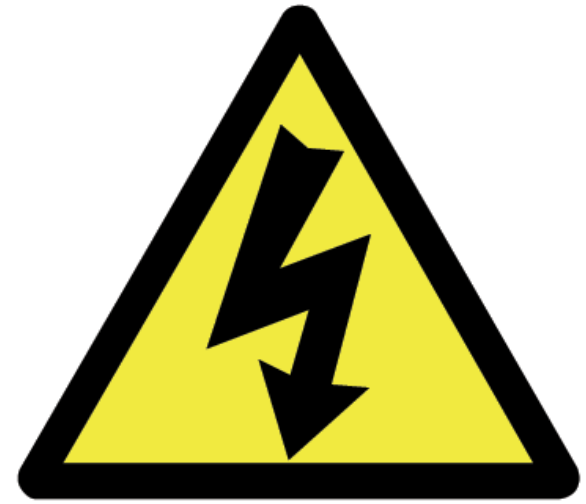
