Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for your support this week whilst we have sought to keep the site running safely. In my email yesterday, I explained that we would review the remote learning and on-site arrangements for all year groups again today and that we would take further contingency measures if required to ensure that the site remains safe and operational.

Following a staffing review this morning and exploring every alternative solution to maintain safe, full school opening we have now made the following alterations to our on-site provision on Thursday 27 and Friday 28 January.

<u>Thursday 27 January</u> <u>Lower School (Reception – Year 4)</u>

Reception - Year 4: All year groups remain open and operational

Middle School (Year 5 - 8)

Year 5-7: Remains open and operational.

Year 8: Will be closed and all students will access remote learning (see below for

details). Key Worker/Vulnerable students will be offered a space to learn

on site in a supervised computer room.

Upper School (Year 9-11)

Year 9 & 11: Remains open and operational.

Year 10: Will be closed and all students will access remote learning (see below for

details). Key Worker/Vulnerable students will be offered a space to learn on

site in a supervised computer room.

Friday 28 January

Lower School (Reception – Year 4)

Reception - Year 4 Currently, we hope that all year groups will remain open, however this will be

re-reviewed on Thursday & a further update will be shared with parents

during the afternoon.

WORK HARD, BE KIND

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Middle School (Year 5-8) - Friday 28 January

Year 5 – 7: Currently will remain open and operational. This will be reviewed on Thursday and if there are any changes to opening arrangements, we will share this information with parents as soon as possible.

Year 8: Will be closed and all students will access remote learning (see below for details). Key Worker/Vulnerable students will be offered a space to learn on site in a supervised computer room.

Upper School (Year 9-11) - Friday 28 January

Year 10 – 11 Currently will remain open and operational.

Year 9 Will be closed and all students (except Key Worker / Vulnerable students) will access remote learning (see below for details).
