
Setting up for the day. Students uniform, homework and equipment will be checked. Students are required to bring a pen, pencil, rubber and ruler as a minimum each day.



Phone call home. **Right Place, Right Time:** • Students who are out of lessons without permission will be sent to the reflection room, lose 20 minutes of social time and a phone call home will be made. Serious or dangerous behaviour will result in a straight removal and reflection. An unsuccessful reflection will result in a day of rebuild.

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BEHAVIOUR SANCTIONS

- Failure to meet expectations will result in students remaining in the academy until 3:30pm.
- Failure to follow the rules of Reflection will result in students working in isolation and repeating a full day in Reflection before they can return to lessons.
- More than one visit to Reflection in a day will result in students staying in the academy until 4pm that same day.
- Damage to academy will property will result in a bill for repairs / replacement.
- If a student is excluded, they cannot return to normal lessons until a reintegration meeting with a parent has been completed.
